- ❖ aims at training **researchers** who will be able to carry out independent, data-based investigations of both a quantitative and qualitative nature, and to **publish** the results in Hungarian and international journals,
- ❖ is run by the **Department of English Language Pedagogy** and the **Department of English Applied Linguistics** of the School of English and American Studies of Eötvös Loránd University.

PhD courses: obligatory and elective

- ❖ **research methods** (e.g., Research seminars, Research design and statistics, Qualitative research design, How to write a research paper in English, etc.)
- ❖ **applied linguistics** (e.g., Discourse analysis, Researching EAP, Researching ESP discourse, English as a lingua franca, Pragmatics, Translation studies, etc.)
- ❖ **educational management and policy** (e.g., Language planning and the ELT curriculum, Political issues in ELT, Educational policy, etc.)
- ❖ **teaching, learning and teacher education** (e.g., Individual differences in second language learning, Second language motivation, Writing professional ELT materials, Classroom assessment in language education, etc.)
- ❖ **culture and intercultural communication** (e.g., Researching intercultural communication, Teaching culture through language, Understanding the intercultural experience, Language education for intercultural competence development, etc.)

PhD Programme in Language Pedagogy and English Applied Linguistics

- ❖ **65** of our students **have defended their PhD** dissertation
- ❖ our teaching staff consists of around **20 tutors** (from DEAL and DELP of ELTE and other universities)
- ❖ we currently have **24 supervisors**
- ❖ since 2007, we have regularly been publishing the work of our PhD students in the online, double blind peer reviewed journal *Working Papers in Language Pedagogy*

Eötvös Loránd University: founded in 1635



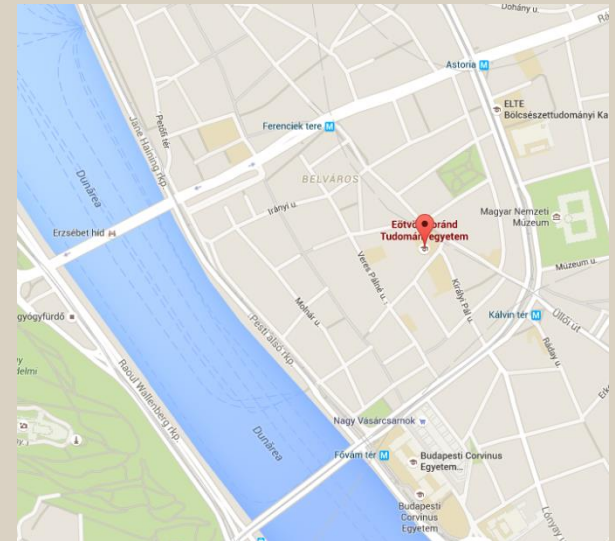
The university, founded by Péter Pázmány, Cardinal of Esztergom, was **originally launched as a Jesuit university** consisting of a **humanities and a theology faculty**. Our Faculty started academic work right after foundation, on 13 November 1635.

Roots of teacher training: the **Jesuits** launched special **training courses for teachers** in the **1700s**.

The Faculty of Humanities today with its **18 institutes** and nearly **8,000 students** is the **largest faculty of Hungarian higher education**, with the **largest teacher training portfolio**.

Facts about the Faculty

- ❖ Absolute first for over 10 years in the nationwide rankings
- ❖ Student population ~ 8,000 (with large foreign student community)
- ❖ ~ 50 BA programs
- ❖ over 60 MA programs
- ❖ ~ 25 teacher training MA programs
- ❖ over 70 PhD programs
- ❖ over 70 languages (ancient and modern) and cultures (2nd in the world, after Beijing International Studies University – 98 languages)
